301 DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the role of EMID administration (the Executive Director and integration program supervisors) and its relationship with the Board.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Effective leadership and sound management practices are essential to realizing educational excellence. It is the responsibility of the EMID administration to develop an environment that recognizes the dignity of each student and employee, and the right of each student to access educational programs and services.
- B. The Board expects all activities related to the operation of the integration programs to be administered in a well-planned manner, conducted in an orderly fashion, and consistent with the policies of the Board.
- C. The Board shall seek specific recommendations, background information and professional advice from the district administration, and will hold the administration accountable for sound management of the integration programs.
- D. Although the Board holds the Executive Director ultimately responsible for leadership of the district, the Board also recognizes the direct responsibility of integration program supervisors for educational results and effective leadership of the integration programs.
- E. The Board and administration shall work together to share information and decisions that best serve the needs of EMID students within existing financial and facility constraints.
